

# How do I participate?

**REGISTER** – Visit <u>carlsbadlibrary.beanstack.org</u> or use the Beanstack Tracker app for Android or iOS. Log into your account or create one if you are a new reader. Sign up for the Summer Reading Adventure challenge that matches your grade or age.

RECORD – Read and complete activities to earn points. Track your progress in Beanstack. Can't get to a computer? Ask for a paper log at the library to track your reading and activities.



**REWARDS** – Earn reading rewards while supplies last. Visit your local Carlsbad City Library location to pick up your rewards. Last day to pick up is Aug. 20.
