



Frequently Asked Questions

PARKING

How can I get a parking pass?

Parking passes are reserved for people working at TGIF, city staff who have done extensive work to make TGIF happen, full page advertisers in our program, and city officials. Parking passes are not for sale.

What about handicapped parking?

We have spots reserved for those with handicapped placards. They are limited in number, so we request that if you want to assure yourself a parking space that you arrive early. If there are no more handicapped spots available when you arrive, we have pick up/drop off spaces available.

Where can I park?

At Stagecoach Park there is parking at the high school across the street and the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Days Saints down the road. At all other parks we have designated parking areas with a shuttle to and from the concert. Please see the program or a flyer for details about parking lots. You may also consider using a ride-share service.

Are parking passes available?

Parking passes are reserved for people working at TGIF, city staff working the concert(s), city officials or their designee, and concert sponsors who contributed a full-page ad to the souvenir program.

Where do I pick up the shuttle?

Shuttle service is available for Poinsettia, Calavera Hills and Alga Norte Community Parks. Shuttles run from 4:15 pm – 9:15 p.m. Two to three shuttles will operate on a continuous basis from shuttle pick up locations to the concert site and back. All offsite parking lots open at 4 p.m.

Will there be handicapped parking?

Designated parking has been made available for vehicles with proper handicapped placards. They are limited in number and are first come first served.

INSIDE THE PARK

Are pets allowed?

No pets allowed in city parks at any time. All on-site dog parks will be closed at 3 p.m. on concert days. Service animals as defined by Title II and III of Americans with Disabilities Act are welcome.

Is alcohol allowed?

Yes. We request that you always drink responsibly. We have a friendly and helpful crew should you find yourself needing assistance.

Are gas grills or open flame BBQ allowed?

No.

Is smoking/vaping allowed?

Smoking and vaping are prohibited anywhere inside city parks. Smoking & vaping is allowed outside the park boundaries.

Can space be reserved on the field?

You are welcome to bring blankets and chairs for a group at 4 p.m. or after. We request that you only take the space that you need. Seating is limited.

Are low and high back chairs allowed?

A chair that sits lower than 8 inches from the ground is considered a low-back chair and is allowed for the duration of the concert. If the chair does not meet that definition, they can be used up until the concert starts, and then we ask that they be collapsed to avoid obstructing views.

Lost and Found?

YES. Look for the clearly marked sun-shaded canopies with Lost & Found banners.
