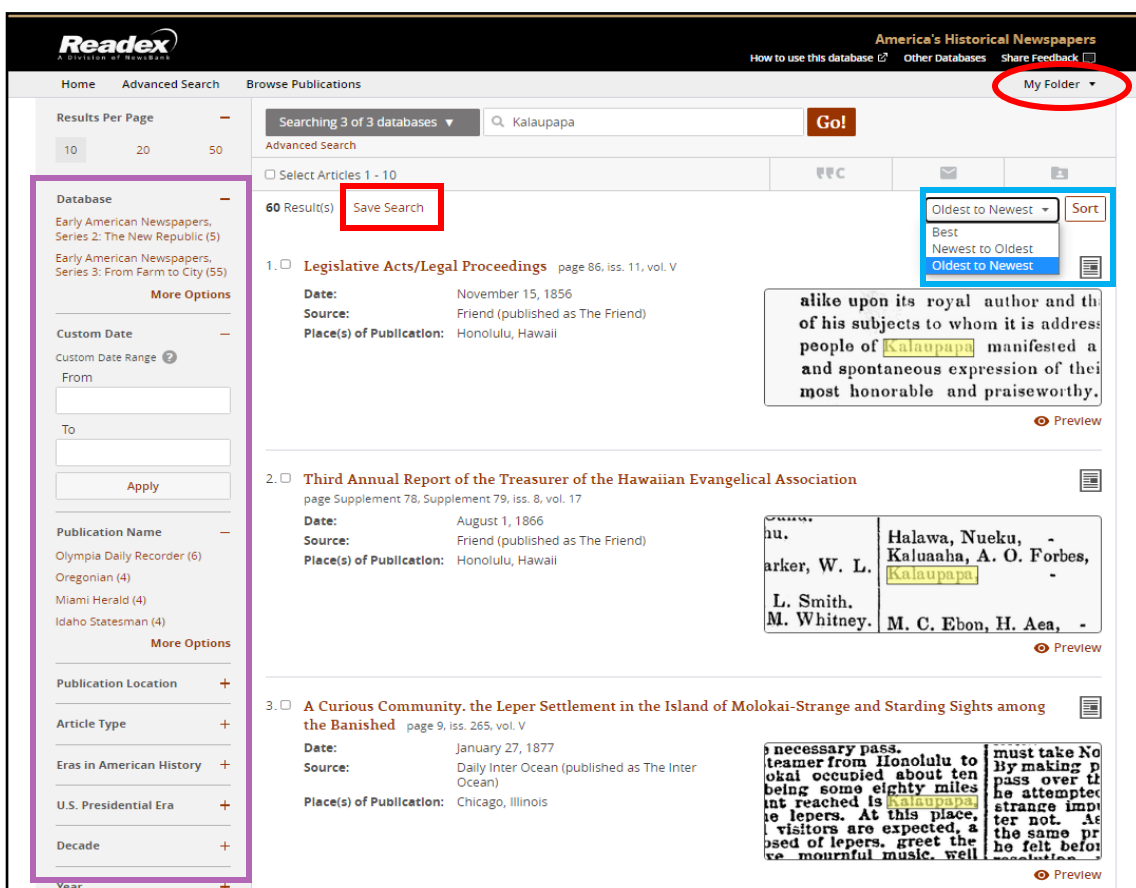
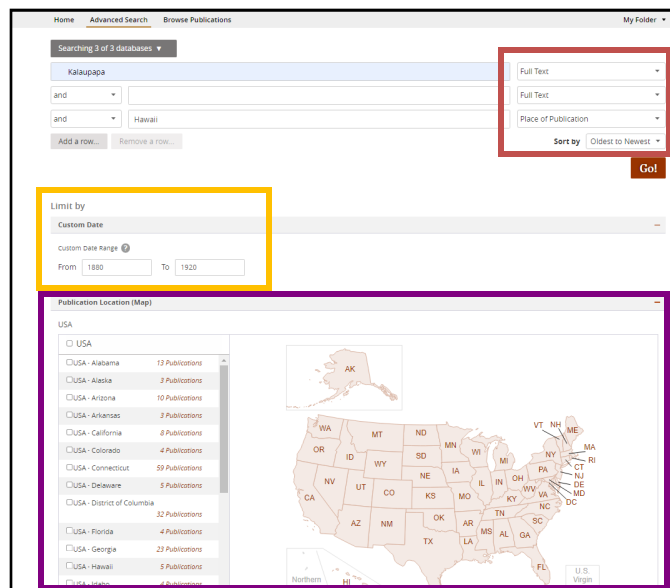
To get started searching, simply enter a keyword or name in the search well. You can choose to search across all three series or select specific series to narrow your search.

Searching

Advanced search allows you enter multiple keywords across a variety of **categories**, including full text, headline, publication title and date.

There is also a separate field where you can limit by **date** or use an interactive **map** to limit by publication place.



- Create an account to **save** your searches and individual articles.
- **Sort** your matches
- There are many unique ways to **limit** your results, such as by Eras in American History or U. S. Presidential Era

Viewing Results
