

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to you that the Planning Commission of the City of Carlsbad will hold a public hearing at the Council Chamber, 1200 Carlsbad Village Drive, Carlsbad, California, at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, **May 3, 2023**, to consider a request for the following:

CASE NAME: CDP 2021-0044, HDP 2022-0008, SUP 2021-0002, SUP 2022-0002 (PUB 2020-0009) – El Camino Real Widening from Jackspar Drive to Sunny Creek Road

PUBLISH DATE: April 21, 2023

DESCRIPTION: A request to recommend approval of a Coastal Development Permit, Hillside Development Permit, Special Use Permit (Floodplain), a Special Use Permit (El Camino Real Corridor), and a waiver of General Plan Open Space Policy 4-P.6 to allow for roadway improvements, including widening of the northbound segment of El Camino Real for approximately 2,300 feet from Jackspar Drive to Sunny Creek Road. The Project will also add approximately 245 feet of sidewalk and striping of bicycle lanes in the northbound direction of El Camino Real between Sunny Creek Road and Jackspar Drive. The Project is located within the Mello II Segment of the city's Local Coastal Program and Local Facilities Management Zone 22. The City Planner has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (d) Class 3 new construction or conversion of small structures.

Those persons wishing to speak on this proposal are cordially invited to attend the public hearing and provide the decision makers with any oral or written comments they may have regarding the project. All materials exhibited to the Planning Commission during the meeting (slides, maps, photos, etc.) are part of the public record and must be kept by the Planning Division for at least 60 days after final action on the matter. APPEALS

The time within which you may judicially challenge these projects, if approved, is established by State law and/or city ordinance and is very short. If you challenge this project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Carlsbad at or prior to the public hearing.

- Appeals to the City Council:** Where the decision is appealable to the City Council, appeals must be filed in writing within ten (10) calendar days after a decision by the Planning Commission.
- Coastal Commission Appealable Project:**
 - This site is located within the Coastal Zone Appealable Area.
 - This site is not located within the Coastal Zone Appealable Area.
 - Application deemed complete: February 2, 2023

Where the decision is appealable to the Coastal Commission, appeals must be filed with the Coastal Commission within ten (10) working days after the Coastal Commission has received a Notice of Final Action from the City of Carlsbad. Applicants will be notified by the Coastal Commission of the date that their appeal period will conclude.
