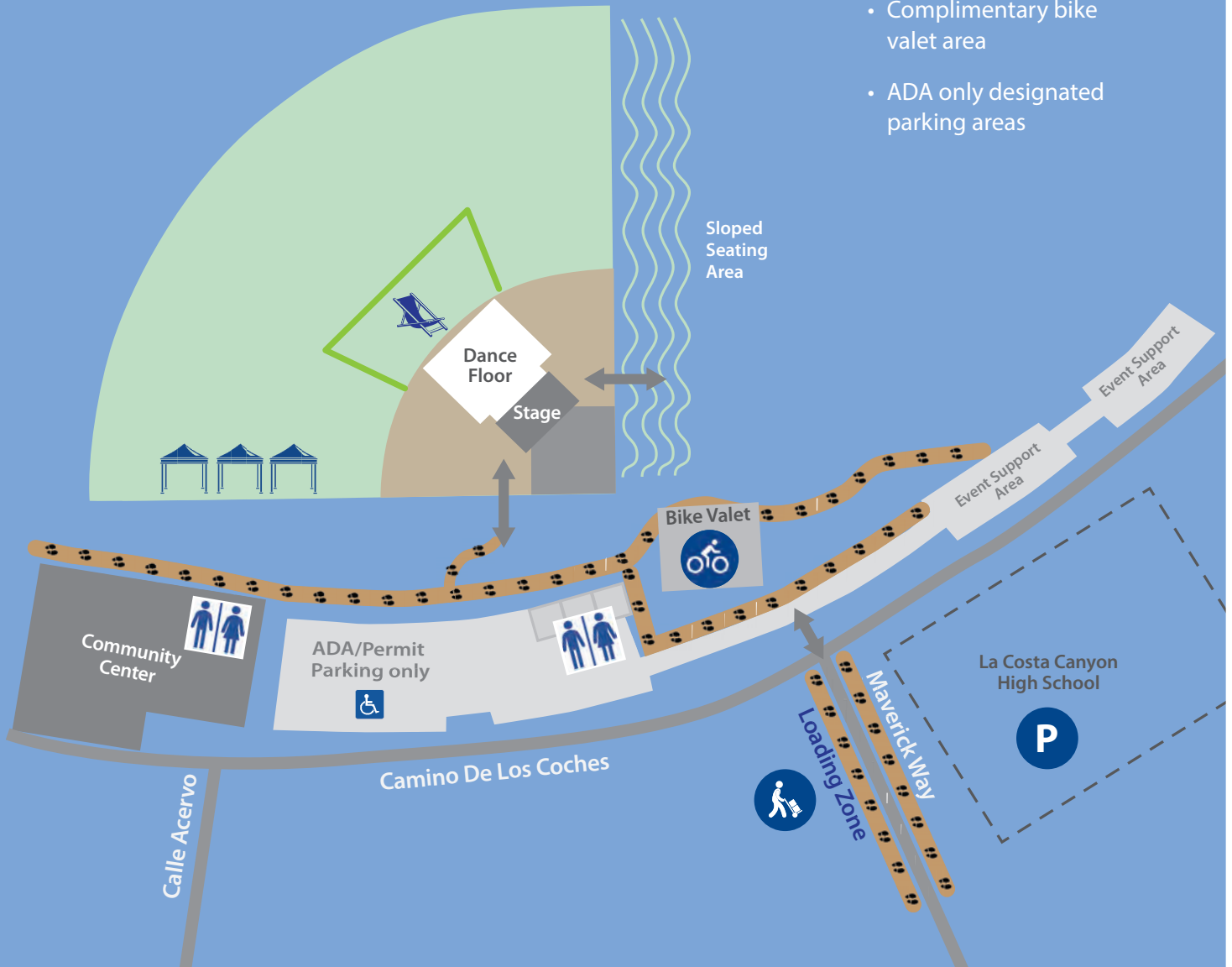

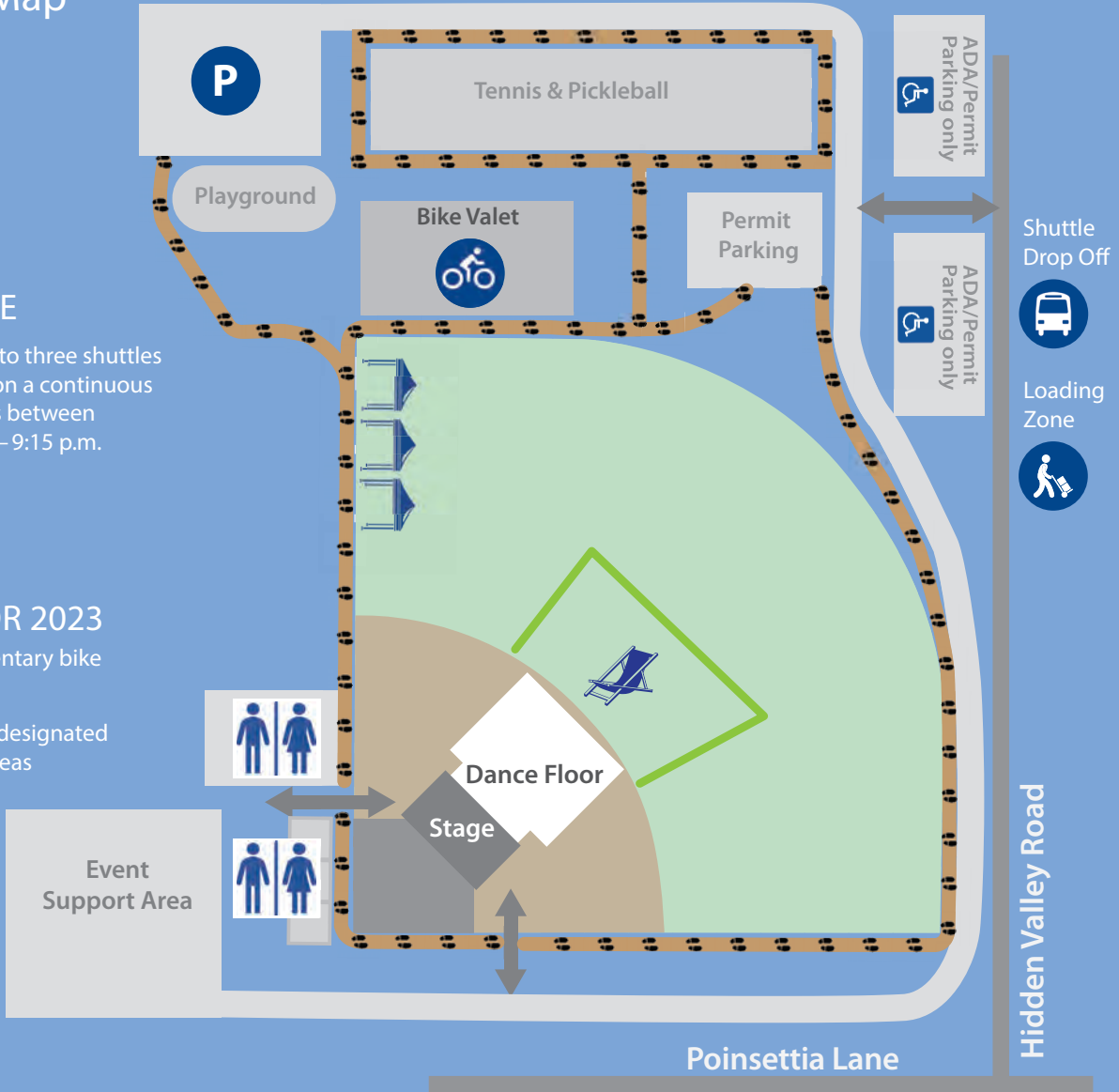
Jungle Fire

Welcome to TGIF Concerts in the Parks

TGIF is one of the longest running municipally sponsored summer concert series in San Diego County. For 36 years, friends, family and neighbors from across the city have come together to enjoy a safe, clean, welcoming family-friendly experience, and we'd like to keep it that way.

Please be mindful of yourself and others and follow these simple guidelines while you visit our city parks this season.

Shuttle & Rideshare Information

Getting to and from the parks is as easy as a shuttle ride! Here are the best ways to get to the parks this summer:

Shuttles

At all concerts held at Poinsettia, Calavera Hills and Alga Norte community parks, FREE shuttle service runs continuously from 4:15 to 9:15 p.m. for all audience members.

Rideshare

We also recommend utilizing a rideshare service to and from the concerts. Use the concert location for drop off and pick up and head toward the loading zones.

Parking Information

- ✓ There is NO PUBLIC PARKING this season.
- ✓ All onsite parking will be designated for ADA use only.
- ✓ Loading zones are available at all parks and will be clearly marked.
- ✓ Shuttle parking is available at the Poinsettia, Calavera Hills and Alga Norte parks.
- ✓ New for 2023, Ebike valet service will be available at all four parks.
- ✓ ALL parking signs will be enforced.

You will be ticketed if you:

- Park in a designated bike lane
 - Block a fire hydrant
 - Block residential or commercial driveways
 - Park in a fire lane or loading zone
- ✓ Please be courteous of our neighbors. Do not leave any trash or walk across private property.
 - ✓ Please park in designated areas, including off-site parking lots at all concert venues.





is prohibited by applicable federal, state and local laws.

Recycle The city is actively participating in environmental sustainability. We ask that you do your part to support this effort. Republic Service will provide trash, compost and recycle bins at the concert site. Please use them.

Prohibited Items and Activities

- ✓ Smoking or vaping of any kind is prohibited within city parks at any time
- ✓ Bicycles inside concert venues. FREE bike valet is available at every park
- ✓ Banners or large signs
- ✓ Personal barbeque pits or grills of any kind
- ✓ Weapons or drugs of any kind

Concert Site Policies

Chairs The front center section is restricted to low-backed chairs (seat 8 inches or less from the ground). In all other sections, it is recommended to bring low-backed chairs. See site maps of each concert location for location of the low-backed chair section on pages 9, 11, 12 and 14.

Umbrellas Sunshade or umbrellas can be used until 6 p.m.

- ✓ At 6 p.m. all sunshades and umbrellas must be taken down.
- ✓ The only exception is along the back fence.
- ✓ Any canopy-like structures may only be set up along the back fence at any event.

All shade structure policies can change at any time at the discretion of the city and will be enforced.

Aisleways For safety, audience members may not stand, sit or dance in the aisles. The dance floor in front of the stage is reserved for dancing; grass areas are reserved for seating.

Children and Families Children are always welcome, but please keep a watchful eye on them and keep them with you at all times. Any young artists visiting Pop Up Art must be accompanied by an adult.

Code of Conduct Any conduct that is not specifically noted by these rules is prohibited during TGIF events if it interferes with or disrupts another visitor's peaceful enjoyment of a performance, endangers public health or safety, may damage park property, or

Carlsbad Municipal Code 11.32 defines unlawful acts in Carlsbad parks and beaches.

During TGIF concerts, violations of the Municipal Code will be enforced.

- ✓ Sales of any items (both for profit and non-profit) are not allowed without a valid permit issued by the City Council.
- ✓ Distribution or posting of any handbills, circulars or advertising devices is prohibited.
- ✓ Conduct or solicitation of any business is prohibited.
- ✓ Individual or groups are not allowed to arrange for privately catered on-site food or beverage service within concert boundaries.

Pets & Service Animals

- ✓ No pets allowed in concert venue at any time.
- ✓ Only dogs that meet the requirements of Title II and III of the Americans with Disabilities Act are welcome.
- ✓ Be prepared to be asked what skill your animal is trained to do.
- ✓ Any animal not on a leash will be turned away.



Consent to be Photographed

By your presence at the event, you hereby consent to and assign all rights to your portrait, picture, videotape and sound recording (collectively "Photograph") of you or in which you may be included intact or in part, composite or distorted in character or form, without restriction to the City of Carlsbad, a municipal corporation, and you hereby authorize the reproduction, copyright, exhibition, broadcast, cablecast, Internet posting, and/or distribution through any and all media now or hereafter known of said Photographs without limitation for purpose of this use. You waive the right to any fees, royalties, or control, now or in



the future, and you grant full permission for the use of your Photograph, including without limitations, your likeness, performance, voice, name and biography for the purpose of publicizing, advertising, or promoting any City of Carlsbad matter or program. You relinquish any right that you may have to examine or approve the completed product or products or the advertising

copy or digital or printed matter that may be used in conjunction therewith or the use to which it may be applied.

If you do not agree to the above terms and conditions please notify the city staff or the photographer/videographer. Otherwise, your presence will be deemed to be your valid consent to be photographed and videotaped.

- Food soiled paper (napkins, paper plates, paper containers, pizza boxes, coffee filters)
- Green material (landscaping, pruning waste, sticks, leaves, wood), and only certified compostable products
- No plastic, glass, metal or bags

How is it processed?

Your materials are taken to the Otoy Compost Facility where it is then composted into a nutrient rich soil additive and mulch that can be used in your gardens and community parks. Compost will be available to city residents for FREE pick-up during annual giveaway events.

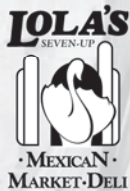
