

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to you that the Planning Commission of the City of Carlsbad will hold a public hearing at the Council Chamber, 1200 Carlsbad Village Drive, Carlsbad, California, at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, **July 19, 2023**, to consider a request for the following:

CASE NAME: ZCA2020-0003 and LCPA 2020-0007 (PUB2020-0004) - Citywide Objective Design

Standards for Multifamily Housing and Mixed-Use Development Projects

**PUBLISH DATE:** July 7, 2023

**DESCRIPTION:** A city-initiated amendment to the Zone Code (ZCA 2020-0003) and Local Coastal Program (LCPA 2020-0007) to implement Housing Element Program 1.11 to develop citywide objective design standards for multifamily housing and mixed-use development projects to conform with recent state law regulations. The project provides clear and consistent design direction for eligible projects that does not change allowable uses or building intensities.

Those persons wishing to speak on this proposal are cordially invited to attend the public hearing and provide the decision makers with any oral or written comments they may have regarding the project.
