

Fiscal Year 2023-24 Community Arts Grants Funding Plan

The City of Carlsbad's Cultural Arts Office Fiscal Year 2023-24 Community Arts Grants (CAG) program supports projects and activities that provide quality arts and cultural programming within Carlsbad. Funds are available for organizations, schools and individuals through a competitive application and review process.

The Foundant Technologies grant management system was utilized for the Fiscal Year 2023-24 cycle. This cloud-based software streamlines the application process for grantees and includes a full suite of tracking and reporting tools to improve the overall experience for all users.

In April 2023, 11 panelists reviewed and scored Fiscal Year 2023-24 CAG applications digitally via the Foundant grants management system. The panelists included representatives from regional arts organizations, nonprofits, education specialists and community members.

The total grant funds available for the Fiscal Year 2023-24 grant cycle is \$117,128. The previous grant cycle was funded at the same level.

Each grant was evaluated and categorized into one of four funding areas:

- 1. Arts Organizations: Arts Projects
- 2. Educational Institutions or Affiliated Groups
- 3. Emerging Artists
- 4. Emerging Arts Organizations

A fifth funding area, capacity building, was eliminated in 2023-24. There were no grant submissions for Emerging Artists or Emerging Arts Organizations. Panelists scored each application on a rubric with three sections worth 10 points each for 30 possible points. All scores were averaged and assigned the equivalent percentage SCORE by the Foundant grants management system. Carlsbad Art Wall, A Snyder Art Project

REQUEST: \$7,500 AWARD: \$5,948

Project Description: The Carlsbad Art Wall is a rotating mural wall in the heart of the Carlsbad Village. On this single exterior wall, a new mural will be painted approximately every two months by a new artist.

Campana Studios: Printmaking and Bookbinding Workshops

REQUEST: \$7,500 AWARD: \$5,198

Project Description: Campana Studios will host a series of printmaking and bookbinding workshops led by dynamic teaching artists, who each have extensive experience in leading community-based art programming.

Carlsbad Oceanside Art League: Demo & Expression

REQUEST: \$4,519 AWARD: \$3,563

Project Description: Ten live demonstrations with dialogue and hands-on painting between a professional Instructor and the artists and/or audience.

Carlsbad Playhouse: Playreaders Performance Series

REQUEST: \$7,500 AWARD: \$5,948

Project Description: A series of seven readings will be produced, presenting a wide range of styles and genres of plays and musicals.

Fleet Science Center: Science of Instruments at the Libraries

REQUEST: \$7,500 AWARD: \$6,698

Project Description: In collaboration with the City of Carlsbad libraries, Fleet Science Center will provide young learners with engaging hands-on educational workshops that enhance knowledge in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) that feature a component of arts education.

Project Description: Hands of Peace is planning to partner with Carlsbad filmmakers to provide 42 youth with the skills to express their visions for the future through film.

North Coast Repertory Theatre: Shakespeare in Schools

REQUEST: \$7,500 AWARD: \$6,698

Project Description: Support for The Theatre School @ North Coast Rep for performances of Shakespeare plays at Carlsbad schools with a combined cast of students and professional adults.

Patrons of the Arts (dba Carlsbad Community Theatre): Theatre Tech Training Program

REQUEST: \$7,500 AWARD: \$6,698

Project Description: This program targets teens and young adults who want to learn various roles in tech theatre.

San Diego Art Institute: The Valise Project

REQUEST: \$7,500 AWARD: \$5,198

Project Description: Support for arts outreach program to cover costs of teaching artist, education staff, transportation, art-making materials for students and administrative costs for visits to Carlsbad schools.

Soultry Sisters: Summer Soulstice Arts & Wellness Festival

REQUEST: \$7,500 AWARD: \$5,948

Project Description: Host a three-day festival highlighting black, indigenous and people of color (BIPOC), women and queer artists and wellness practitioners based in San Diego.

REQUEST: \$ 3,500 AWARD: \$2,748

Project Description: Community Commitment: A mosaic project is a collaborative tile project that will focus on several communal areas around campus that require some aesthetic improvements.

Carlsbad High School: Dance Extreme Spring Showcase

REQUEST: \$3,500 AWARD: \$3,098

Project Description: The Dance Extreme Showcase is a production held each spring providing all Carlsbad High School dance students an opportunity to choreograph, rehearse and perform unique dances based on the disciplines of jazz, modern, hip-hop, ballet and the most recently added - Pom.

Project Description: Sage Creek Drama Department collaborates on a production written especially for young audiences and all CUSD elementary and middle schools are invited to attend for free on a field trip.

Project Description: Sage Creek students will participate at the Festival of the Arts through a series of living art exhibits.

Valley Middle School: Ceramic Art /Craft Scavenger Hunt in the Carlsbad Village

REQUEST: \$3,500 AWARD: \$3,098

Project Description: Students from four art classes will create mini craft/sculpture artwork using hot glue, craft and ceramic sculpted accessories. Each mini sculpture art will be hidden in the Carlsbad Village as a city-wide scavenger hunt.

Valley Middle School Band & Orchestra: Guest Artists/Coaches for Small Group Ensembles

REQUEST: \$3,500 AWARD: \$3,098

Project Description: Support the 2023-24 Valley Middle School (VMS) band and orchestra program to fund essential teaching artists and coaches to help lead our band and orchestra students by conducting small group rehearsals.
