Watershed Protection

Only rain in the storm drain! Storm drains flow directly into our creeks, lagoons and ocean. Rain



water and urban runoff can transport pollutants such as trash, oil, pet waste and fertilizers downstream.

Do not dump or wash anything to any outdoor drain.

Check your facility before forecasted rain and clean up as needed.

Cover or move materials and equipment to prevent contact with rain water.

Prevent runoff from sprinklers by regularly checking irrigation systems.
