The TGIF Concerts in the Park have been annually conducted by the City of Carlsbad since the 1980s, ranging in hosting 4 to 12 events each year. In 2022 there were six concerts held. Adoption of a resolution allocating additional funding for additional concerts, estimated at three additional concerts, is consistent with historic practices of the concert. Furthermore, the concerts take place in existing developed parks, have operational traffic control, and will have no permanent impact on the physical or natural environments of the developed park facilities. No exception to the exemption as sets forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 or the Carlsbad Municipal Code Section 19.04.070 (B) apply.
