






LEAST TERN SITE PREP

CALIFORNIA LEAST TERN DATA



2016 - <u>44</u> flowering plants

2017 - 216 flowering plants

Threats: unauthorized access/trails, nonnative annual grasses

2016 - 78 flowering plants

2017 - **108** flowering plants

Threats: Nonnative annual grasses and forbs

1-acre Preserve (0.33 acre extent)



Brodiaea filifolia

2016-based on a count of $\underline{835}$ flowering individuals, we estimated $\underline{3,444}$ 2017-based on a count of $\underline{4,163}$ flowering individuals, we estimated $\underline{18,230}$

Threats: Nonnative annual grasses and forbs

Acmispon prostratus - Nuttall's lotus

Since 1997, W2 remains virtually unchanged from year-to-year due to annual weed management for CA least tern nesting. Site is also fenced.
