About the commission

The Historic Preservation Commission consists of members who must have knowledge of and a demonstrated interest in historic preservation and local history. The commission acts in an advisory capacity to the City Council, Planning Commission and Housing Commission in all matters relating to the identification, protection, retention, and preservation of historic resources within the city.

The Historic Preservation Commission shall consist of five members to be appointed by the Mayor, with the approval of the City Council. Members serve four-year terms (unless appointed to fill an unexpired term).

These vacancies consist of the following category:

<u>Two vacancies</u>: Scheduled (Category A – Members each of whom has a background or interest in architecture, archeology, history, biology, engineering, geology, or a related field).

Eligibility

Members must be residents of Carlsbad and registered voters.

Meeting dates/times

Regular meetings are held in the City Council chamber on the second Monday of each odd month at 6 p.m.

Commissioner requirements/duties

Attend commission meetings File an annual "Statement of Economic Interests" form Complete ethics training every two years

Appointment process

Applications are available on the city's website at www.carlsbadca.gov and in the City Clerk's Office, City Hall at 1200 Carlsbad Village Drive, Carlsbad.

The Mayor will nominate an applicant at a City Council meeting. Approval from a majority of the City Council is required to confirm the appointment.
