As a creative design and fabrication team, we are always happy to see the beautification of locations and the proliferation of the art and design scene. As a San Diego based firm, we are elated to see the Veterans Memorial Park area being revived into an, evoking, and inspiring part of San Diego. With this location is in our back yard, the opportunity to be a part of this process is extremely enticing. With our three founding members graduating from San Diego's NewSchool of Architecture and Design, Tecture has roots in San Diego and loves this city. We are always looking for opportunities to build within our neighborhoods and feel pride in the elevation of San Diego's art and design scene. We regularly host design and art events at our studio and our team members participate in many different creative fields throughout the region.

As a whole, Tecture is a design and fabrication studio that lives at the intersection of art and architecture. Our team of competent creatives finds fun in design; crafting outside-the-box projects both for our clients and to fulfill our own passions. We do not operate under a given style, but allow the design process (and client needs/brand/etc.) to guide the final outcome for the project. Each project has a unique site and objectives, so should each project should naturally look and feel different.

Tecture excels in the 3-dimensional, mixed-material realm, and can create dynamic artwork to enhance the effects of the overall space. In addition, our previous experiences in large scale, site integrated artwork makes us well suited for the challenges and puzzles of complex sculptures and installations. We are adept at navigating the creative, engineering, fabrication, and installation needs of such projects. In house we have a mixed bag of creatives, from interior designers to steel workers. Our ability to traverse the divides between design, fabrication, and material research allows us to come up with new solutions and artistic interpretations to suit the wide range of projects that we bring to life.

Within the last five years, Tecture has completed upwards of 20 architectural art installations that include exterior, interior, wall-mounted, suspended, illuminated, and functional artistic pieces. These features are installed in a wide range of industry sectors, existing in biotech campuses, medical facilities, corporate offices, hospitality projects, and residential buildings. Although each of our art installations are different in scope and scale, we are able to confidently navigate schedule and budgetary constraints. Our past range of contract amounts for architectural art features ranges from \$25k to \$375k. Tecture is able to support contracts of larger amounts and has contracted on projects with values above \$1M.

All together, we see each of the Veterans Memorial Park as a fantastic opportunity to enhance the environmental experience in which the art is installed, and we feel supremely confident that we can create stunning pieces that have a strong visual and experiential impact.

	This piece is an abstract representation of the schooling and flocking behaviors that are present in biological populations. The 20' Wide by 12' Tall piece is comprised of 10,000 pounds of locally sourced beach stones suspended ob 246 individual cables.
02 - TUNNEL VISION SAN DIEGO, 2021	Medium: Steel, Wood Client: HealthPeak Budget: \$135k Dimensions: 15' X 25' X 25'
	This was developed in order to give the patrons of the campus a shaded exterior location in which to enjoy the view off the ledge. Positioned on the campus walkway, this overhead structure utilized shifting arches of steel to create the structure, while the wood striations provide the shade and help tie the piece together. The linear wood slats help frame the view even more as it drives the eye toward the walkway edge.
03 - COLUMBIA PARKLET SAN DIEGO, 2021	Medium: Powder-coated Steel Mesh, Wood Client: Downtown San Diego Partnership Budget: \$80k Dimensions: 14' X 10'
	Located in the heart of Downtown, San Diego, this mesh parklet provides a bright and inviting opportunity for people passing by to take a seat and relax. Created by stacking welded wire mesh to create a unique structure, powder-coated in a bright orange, it makes it an intriguing piece that is impossible to miss.

	Inspired by the organic forms of nature, organic developments, and natural flow & curves, this pair of benches resides on a campus in the heart of Torrey Pines scientific research area. We wanted to capture the energy of all our inspirations into a functional form that was beautiful and inviting to guests. Created by stacking reclaimed Torrey Pines wood in a sweeping curve, integrated with a large slab that provides deep seating and a comfortable back rest.
