About the commission

The Planning Commission shall consist of seven members. The Mayor and each Council Member shall nominate one individual to serve on the commission for a term coinciding with the term of the Council Member making the appointment.

All nominations shall be subject to ratification by a majority vote of the City Council, pursuant to Section 2.15.050 of the Carlsbad Municipal Code.

The Planning Commission holds regularly scheduled public hearings to consider land use matters, such as the general plan, local coastal program, growth management program, specific plans, master plans, amendments to the zoning ordinance, zone changes, special studies, and discretionary development permits for public and private projects.

Eligibility

Members must be residents of Carlsbad and registered voters.

Meeting dates/times

Regular meetings are held in the City Council Chamber the first and third Wednesday of the month at 5 p.m.

Commissioner requirements/duties

Attend commission meetings
File an annual "Statement of Economic Interests" form
Complete ethics training every two years

Appointment process

Applications are available on the city's website at www.carlsbadca.gov and in the City Clerk's Office, City Hall at 1200 Carlsbad Village Drive, Carlsbad.

Council Member Teresa Acosta representing District 4 will nominate an applicant at a City Council meeting. Approval from a majority of the City Council is required to confirm the appointment.
