About the commission

The Beach Preservation Commission shall investigate, research and make recommendation to the City Council and the City Manager on general coastal topics, studies, and programs, including, but not limited to the following:

- Protecting and enhancing the shoreline (e.g., littoral cells and sea level rise)
- Preventing beach erosion
- Preserving and maintaining beaches for the safety and optimum enjoyment of the public.

The Beach Preservation Commission shall consist of seven members to be appointed by the Mayor, with the approval of the City Council. Members serve four-year terms (unless appointed to fill an unexpired term).

Eligibility

Members must be residents of Carlsbad and registered voters.

Meeting dates/times

Regular meetings are held in the City Council chamber the first Tuesday of each even month.

Commissioner requirements/duties

Attend commission meetings.

File an annual "Statement of Economic Interests" form.

Complete ethics training every two years.

Appointment process

Applications are available on the city's website at www.carlsbadca.gov and in the City Clerk's Office, City Hall at 1200 Carlsbad Village Drive, Carlsbad.

The Mayor will nominate an applicant at a City Council meeting. Approval from a majority of the City Council is required to confirm the appointment.
