What is CDBG?

Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) are funds from the federal government that must be used for programs and services assisting low- and moderate-income Carlsbad residents. To receive these funds, the City must submit a five-year strategy, known as a Consolidated Plan, to the federal government. The City is currently developing its next Consolidated Plan and needs your input at two upcoming community forums to help determine community needs and funding priorities.
