The following unscheduled vacancy exists on the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Advisory Committee in the City of Carlsbad.

One Vacancy – District No. 4

The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Advisory Committee shall consist of seven members. The membership consists of a representative from the Planning Commission, Senior Commission, Housing Commission and four residents representing the City Council Member districts. The CDBG Citizen Advisory Committee reviews grant proposals and makes recommendations regarding CDBG funding allocations to the City Council concerning federal funding. The CDBG Committee members must be residents of Carlsbad and registered voters. Members serve two-year terms. The Committee holds a maximum of three meetings per year in the months of March and April.
