
The Source of the Data Used in This Site

The parcel data used in this site is from SanGIS (www sangis org), the city and county of San Diego's geographic information system base map. Using the assessor parcel number (APN) as the primary relate key, attribute data from the San Diego County Assessor. the City of Carlsbad Planning Department, and the City of Carlsbad's PERMITS Plus System are joined together with the SanGIS percel data to provide a city-wide parcel information system








Click on "Address Search" on the "Searches" field




Fill in "Street Number" and "Street Name" – Click on "Look Up"
