#### Please describe your professional experience and relevant experience.

I have served as a consultant to the City of Encinitas as a Downtown Executive Director, The Hwy 101 Corridor Coordinator, General Plan Update Facilitator & Rail, Streetscape consultant for 21 years. I have served as a Special Projects Coordinator for the city of Carlsbad for 4 years. The organization that I directed in Encinitas and the City of Encinitas won the Great American MainStreet Award from the National Trust of Historic Preservation in 2004.

I owned two Danish bakeries in Carlsbad D1 for 15 years, creating over 50 jobs in the village and a number of other Danish bakeries in Encinitas, Del Mar and New Mexico.

I served as a Field Trial test driver for BMW North America for 6 years, driving prototype hydrogen and electric cars prior to the launch of BMWi division in 2014. I have trained over 200 BMW dealers nationally in the operations and sales of electric vehicles.

I have served as a consultant for Arcimoto, a micro mobility vehicle manufacturer in Eugene Oregon, assisting them in the selection of a site for operations in Downtown San Diego and in obtaining their State of California Manufacturers License and their State of California Dealers License.

I have also served as a strategic advisor to BYTON automotive and a consultant to Sempra Energy working on EV emissions mapping.

#### Please describe your educational background.

I am a native San Diegan. I attended Patrick Henry High School, Mira Mesa Community College and San Diego State.

In my junior year of college, I made the decision to leave my studies and started my first business in Carlsbad. This began my life long career as an entrepreneur and consultant.

I purchased my first home in Carlsbad at the age of 19 and have been a homeowner in Carlsbad ever since.

I believe my experience and the "practice" of my profession through the decades, has provided me with a unique and different educational experience, yet one just as necessary and rewarding as a traditional educational experience, in accomplishing the many goals, projects and initiatives for which I have been involved.

# Please describe your current or past community involvement, including any service on boards, commissions or committees, with private or public agencies.

I have served on several Carlsbad Committees and non profit boards as a resident of Carlsbad. This includes the Housing & Redevelopment Advisor Committee, Design Review Board, Prop E. Steering Committee, Carlsbad Educational Foundation Board, Carlsbad Tourism Board, VBA board, Lagoon Foundation Board and others.

I served for eight years as a San Diego County District 3 Planning Commissioner appointed by Supervisor Pam Slater Price (R) and Supervisor Dave Roberts (D).

I served as the Chairperson of the California Site Selection Committee that secured Carlsbad for the location of the LEGOLAND theme part, prevailing over several hundred competitors nationwide, I also served as the Chairperson of the Political Action Committee (PAC) that secured a "yes" vote during the election for the Carlsbad Ranch Specific Plan (LEGOLAND).

I served as a board member of the California MainStreet Alliance (CAMSA), a California statewide Non Governmental Organization (NGO), whose members provided professional development and technical assistance to certified and aspiring MainStreet cities.

# Please explain why you wish to be appointed to City Council (attach a separate sheet if needed)

I believe that the City of Carlsbad needs stability in terms of tenure and civility in D1. I have never run for public office, but have been previously called to serve and appointed to public office in the County of San Diego. It's not a career choice that I have chosen in the past, although I honor those who do serve and I understand the difficulties and sacrifices public service requires.

I believe that I can be of assistance to the city council and the citizens of Carlsbad. I am by nature a "Hub" or "centrist" personality and a certified facilitator that has a long track record of service and success in complex situations. I have many contributions as a team member or team leader in bringing agencies, communities and projects to a solution in order to move forward.

I have no intentions of running for any public office in Carlsbad or elsewhere in the future.

### What would you like to accomplish as a council person if appointed?

I believe that the current "Decibel Level" of rancor, angst and mistrust is very high in D1. In this heightened tense personalized environment with elevated voices, it's very difficult, if not impossible, for meaningful community discussions on the topics of the day to occur and for consensus to be reached.

In order to effectively govern, the most pressing need is the ability to have productive civic discussions by reducing tensions, seeking to understand, striving to regain trust and healing the divisions in our community among neighbors. We should celebrate our diversity of opinion and lifestyles realizing that's what makes Carlsbad, and specifically D1, so wonderful. I will do everything I can to assist and behave in a manor that seeks to accomplish this. Without civil discourse and calmer waters any future goals one wishes to accomplish will be difficult.

I'd like to see Carlsbad begin the challenging work of developing a successor plan to the Growth Management Plan (GMP). The GMP has been very successful in guiding the development of this community from 35,000 citizens in the 1980's to now over 115,000 citizens. As we are now 95% built out, we need to realize that the GMP is a document that is relevant to the last 5%, but not so relevant to the built environment of the other 95%. A successor plan is needed that focuses on the 95% built environment and how we live & thrive together as a community and as neighbors for the decades to come.

I'd work towards establishing a consensus to begin a certified National Trust for Historic Preservation (NTHP) Mainstreet Program for the Village and if the stakeholders desire, for the Barrio. I'd seek to end the "rotation" of expensive outside consultants who the city has hired to provide a vision for the area. The city should work to develop over time, strong boards, staff and guidance from our residents and business stakeholders, that can guide the future of our neighborhoods.

I would also work towards gaining consensus on accelerating the transition of our vehicle fleet to electric, the strengthening of our measures in the Climate Action Plan, and the information provided to our residents and businesses regarding all emission reduction strategies.

#### Please give examples of using collaboration to become successful.

While our children were in Carlsbad Unified School District, I co-founded and co-chaired with two other parents, Julie Baker and Lynne Crockett, a program called "Kids Are Worth a Million" as part of the Carlsbad Educational Foundation. We were successful beyond our imagination in fundraising and service to our school district. Today, the fruits of this program continue to grow supporting Carlsbad public schools. I am thankful for all who contribute their time and efforts in helping our public schools.

The three of us realized that we each had individual strengths very different from each other, that when combined had the possibility to do something very special. Without collaboration with each other, other school parents, teachers, principals, district administrators, and businesses the effort would not have been successful.

I have mentored several cities and communities, including Vista, Del Mar, Oceanside, Cardiff by the Sea, Leucadia and other regions of California as they began their commercial districts' MainStreet Programs. The core of the program is collaboration among all stakeholders, program staff and city staff to accomplish their unique visions for their MainStreet areas. These programs continue to be successful because of the collaborative structure and efforts resulting in the betterment of their community as they envision it.

Lastly, I grew up as one of 8 siblings learning early on that collaboration is a requirement, not an option. We are all very different and very close knit as a family.

## What are the most pressing issues facing our community and how do you plan to address them?

The transition of the city and guiding policies from a "growth city" to a "built out city."

Fostering more civil and respectful civic discussions, decorum and interactions, while encouraging diversity of opinion.

The stark increase of violent crime in our city and in D1 that has manifested itself in the past few years.

The crisis of the covid pandemic and how it disrupts and effects all aspects of our community.

Reducing our emissions and improving our environmental stewardship with stronger partnerships with nature.

Maintaining and improving the economic, cultural and environmental strength of our city.

In all cases, I will participate with my ideas and suggestions, and more importantly, listen to those ideas and suggestions of others whether on the dais, in a community meeting or elsewhere, so that we can collectively craft the best path forward to address the issue of the day and the improvement of our city.

Carlsbad is and remains a great city to live in, work in & to raise a family in. I am grateful for the leadership and for all who have served this city from its incorporation to today.

I am also thankful for each resident & D1 neighbor who answered the call and submitted an application to fill the council vacancy.
