Please describe your professional experience and relevant experience.

I have over 20 years of experience in multiple aspects of municipal government. I spent five years working for the City of Vista California and fifteen years with the City of San Marcos California where I served as Director of Housing and Neighbor Services. Prior to starting my career in local government, I served eleven years on active duty with the United States Marine Corps. I retired from the Marine Reserves in 2003 at the rank of Lieutenant Colonel with a total 22 years of service to our Country. I have vast leadership experience in tactical, operational, and strategic operations both at the federal and local level. My areas of expertise in local government include housing, parking, code compliance, crime prevention, neighborhood revitalization, redevelopment, volunteer programs, contract services and several federal and state grant programs to include Community Development Block Grant, HOME and CalHOME. While serving as the Director of Housing and Neighborhood Services for the City of San Marcos I had leadership responsibility for day-to-day management and operations of the division to include project management, budgeting, scheduling, capital improvements, contract services, coordination with developers and customer service. I retired from the City of San Marcos in 2017 and joined Citygate as an associate in November of 2018.

Please describe your educational background.

I received my undergraduate education from California State University, Northridge
with a Bachelor of Arts degree in history. I also hold a Master's degree in human
resource management from National University.

Please describe your current or past community involvement, including any service on boards, commissions or committees, with private or public agencies.

I have served as staff liaison to numerous boards and commissions while working for both the City of Vista and San Marcos. I am very familiar with the conduct, rules of order and function of said boards and commissions as well as the City Council. In addition, I also organized and lead community cleanup events in both Vista and in San Marcos. These annual neighborhood cleanups involved hundreds of volunteers painting homes and removing trash from over eleven different neighborhoods here in the north county. These cleanup events were a collaboration of both the public and private agencies. I addition, I have lived in Carlsbad's District 1 since 1992 and I have served on my neighborhood homeowners board of directors.

Please explain why you wish to be appointed to City Council (attach a separate sheet if needed)

I've lived in this wonderful community of Carlsbad for almost 30 years and I believe it is time I step up and help out. I believe I can represent the wants and desires of the residents of District 1 and the city as a whole. I believe I would be a good addition to the current City Council in that I have a common sense approach to things and do not have political aspirations other than the betterment of the City of Carlsbad and the region. I have worked with both staff and councilmembers from our surrounding communities and have a good solid reputation. I believe I could step in fill the vacant seat for District 1, bringing a strong set of skills that would be an asset to the City.

What would you like to accomplish as a council person if appointed?

Carlsbad has done an excellent job in providing a wide variety of housing. I would like to assist in furthering the production of more affordable housing, for all income levels, and work to see a reduction in the homeless population living on our streets and parks. I would also like to see the continued re-vitalization of downtown Carlsbad and surrounding areas while maintaining our coastal "City by the Sea" charm along with more historical preservation of our past.

In addition, I would like to start a recognition program for the companies and businesses that have made Carlsbad their home. As a long-time resident, I am always amazed at the diversity of businesses, both large and small, that I have found while wondering throughout the multiple business parks and commercial centers in town. Carlsbad is a great place to live, raise a family, and do business. One of the great things I love about Carlsbad is the strength and diversity of our business community.

And one last thing I would like to address if appointed to the City Council, review parking along Pacific Coast Highway between Tamarack and Cannon. During the summer months there is a lack of parking. The parking is taken up by out-of-town visitors (we love them, except when their RVs take up all the parking). The RVs are parked almost end to end, all day, along this stretch of beach. Reviewing and discussing parking options that would allow more access to one of the best family beaches in the world would also be one of my goals if appointed to the Council.

Please give examples of using collaboration to become successful.
One of the greatest examples of successful collaboration is the re-vitalizations of existing dilapidated properties or neighborhoods in need. The collaboration between the public and private sectors is key to a successful future in any city. Cities cannot go it alone in maintaining a robust and healthy community. I have led these kinds of collaborations in the past. The example is the Richmar Neighborhood in the City of San Marcos. The collaboration of all departments of the City along with the public and developers, allowed for the revitalization of an entire neighborhood; reducing crime, enhancing the quality of life of the residents with new housing, parks and infrastructure improvements.
What are the most pressing issues facing our community and how do you plan to address them?
The two greatest challenges facing not only Carlsbad, but the region as a whole, are the cost of housing and the rise of homelessness. The City of Carlsbad has done a commendable effort in creating access to both housing, and homeless services. Carlsbad has been on the forefront in the production of affordable housing in the coastal region of north county. I believe I can be a great resource in the efforts towards combating homelessness and the creation of more housing that is affordable to all income groups due to my background. Working together, we can build a Carlsbad where our children and grandchildren want to live, and more importantly, where they can afford to live.
