 In 2016, I moved to Juneau, Alaska. There, I served as the Interim Executive Director and Deputy Director of Juneau's Emergency Shelter/ Soup Kitchen.
 In 2019, I assisted in creating and establishing a local non-profit, People's Legal Services (PLS). PLS provides sliding-scale representation to the under-served portion of the San Diego Community.
 I currently sit on the Executive Board of PLS. I hold the positions of Secretary and Chief Financial Officer.

I graduated from Rancho Buena Vista High School in 2003. I obtained my undergraduate degree from Point Loma Nazarene University. In 2012, I graduated with a Juris Doctorate from California Western School of Law. I am currently earning a Master's Degree from San Diego State University. I plan on graduating from SDSU this Fall.

While at California Western School of Law I served as the Co-Director of the Community Outreach Committee. I also volunteered at the San Diego County Office of the Public Defender and the California Innocence Project.

 I currently serve on the Executive Board of Directors for Peoples Legal Services.

I wish to be appointed to City Council because it serves as an excellent opportunity to give back to my community. The role of public servant carries great responsibility and also provides an avenue to make the community better. I believe I have the skill set to be an effective and competent City Council member.

If appointed, I would like to accomplish the goals put forth by my colleagues and constituents. I would strive to put personal goals aside and be an objective advocate of the community. Working as a team and collaborating with local partners to accomplish mutual goals provide the foundation of success.

Please give examples of using collaboration to become successful.

While in Juneau, Alaska, I identified a large gap in services regarding homelessness. I was able to work together hand-in-hand with local government employees to solve this problem. Through effective collaboration, we were able to create a 'warming center.' This took a tremendous amount of work and negotiations. We were able to find an appropriate location, provide adequate funding, and obtain a trained staff to operate the 'warming center.' This program is still in operation to today's date. While working with People's Legal Services, I learned to build community partners in order to secure grants and other sources of funding. Establishing and maintaining relationships is paramount to success.

What are the most pressing issues facing our community and how do you plan to address them?

The problems facing our community do not deviate from the over-arching problems facing our entire state.

Combating homelessness is a prevalent issue. Working with local organizations and bridging the gap between the private and public sector is a great starting point in the ongoing effort not just to 'manage homelessness,' but to eventually, 'end homelessness.'

The COVID-19 pandemic is another pressing issue in our community. Following Federal Guidelines, adhering to State Guidelines, and listening to the community members of Carlsbad are a few ways to navigate safely through a pandemic.

Protecting small businesses and providing an environment for economic growth in Carlsbad is an issue that constantly requires attention. Advocating for small businesses and allowing economic growth to proliferate are ways to provide a greater economic advantage for the entire community.

I have been a resident of Carlsbad for the majority of my adult life. I am excited for an opportunity to give back to this community. My education and experience make me an excellent candidate for this position. My personality and skill set will allow me to excel in this environment. 
