

# **Appeal & Request for Administrative Hearing**

The following notices may be appealed by filing this form within the timeframe specified below:

- Notice of violation for public nuisance; notice or citation for Ch. 13.06 (FOG) violations—10 days from date of mailing notice
- Administrative citation—30 days from date of citation issuance
- Stop work order or stop use order—30 days from date of issuance/posting of order
- Notice of pending administrative enforcement action—10 days from date of mailing notice
- Proposed lien for administrative costs 45 days from date of issuance of notice
- Notice and order for administrative civil penalties—10 days from date of mailing notice

#### <u>Please note:</u>

- Each violation being appealed must have the reason/ explanation as to why an appeal is being requested for that specific violation.
- For most cases, if your appeal is timely and complete, a hearing will be set not less than fifteen (15) days and not more than sixty (60) days from the date the appeal is filed. Stop work order and stop use order appeals will be scheduled within 10 days from the date the appeal is filed. FOG appeals will be scheduled within thirty (30) days of the city's mailing of a notice of hearing.
- Unless instructed otherwise in a notice, citation or order, mail this completed appeal form and payment of penalty amount to:

• Checks, cashier's checks, or money orders must be made payable to "City of Carlsbad." Do not send cash.

## Administrative citation appeals (excluding FOG appeals):

- Payment of the administrative citation penalty must be received within thirty (30) days of the date of citation in order for an appeal hearing to be scheduled. If the citation is dismissed or cancelled, a refund of the citation penalty paid shall be issued.
- In lieu of payment of the administrative citation penalty, the appellant may file an <u>advance deposit hardship</u> <u>waiver request</u> within ten (10) days of the date of the administrative citation.

## Appeal bodies:

- Administrative citations, notices of violation for public nuisance, notices of pending administrative enforcement action and civil penalties are appealable to an administrative hearing officer.
- Stop work orders and stop use orders are appealable to the city manager or designee, followed by an administrative hearing officer.
- Proposed administrative cost liens are appealable to the Planning Commission, followed by the City Council.
