Project Issue Resolution (PIR) meetings provide customers an opportunity to have permit issues heard and considered by the Community Development Department Director, or in cases involving grading or subdivision ordinance issues, the Transportation Department Director/City Engineer. Customers must first attempt to resolve issues with the appropriate department manager (City Planner, Deputy City Engineer or Building Official) via the department's **Guaranteed Second Opinion** <u>before</u> a PIR meeting will be considered.

Please complete this form and submit to the department manager who provided the Guaranteed Second Opinion. All attempts will be made to schedule PIR meetings within two weeks following form submittal. If you have any questions, please contact your project planner or consult the department's Applicant Resources info-bulletin (<u>IB-110</u>).

Determinations resulting from the PIR process are solely intended to break review logjams and streamline the permit review process. They are not intended to pre-ordain permit approvals. Therefore, PIR determinations are not binding on any city decision-making body including Planning Commission or City Council. The formal appeal of a permit decision shall follow the appropriate appeal processes specified under the applicable <u>Carlsbad Municipal Code</u>.
